

Don't Wait to Vaccinate!

Protect your daughter's future from cervical cancer.

Cervical cancer (cancer of the cervix) is almost always caused by a virus called HPV. HPV is very common. Most people will get infected with HPV at some time in their life. There is no treatment for HPV infection, but there is a vaccine that can prevent it. It is safe and works well.



HPV vaccination helps protect against HPV and can prevent cervical cancer.



When you vaccinate your daughter on time, you give her the best protection from cervical cancer and 4 other cancers that HPV can cause.

Doctors recommend that girls get vaccinated against HPV between 9-14 years. Vaccination at the recommended ages will prevent more cervical cancers than vaccination at older ages.
